

NOVEMBER PROGRAM REVIEWED

Robert Nicholls presented a workshop about Practical Skills for Improvisation to the Greater Kansas City Chapter at the Chapel of Park University in Parkville, Missouri on Monday November 20, 2023. The workshop was an interactive program including a collection of rudimentary to advanced training resource publications as recommended study materials. Individual console coaching was provided for each of the many chapter members who had requested to be coached by Mr. Nicholls.
