# **BACHATHON 2023**

The Greater Kansas City Chapter sponsored the 44<sup>th</sup> annual Bachathon on Sunday May 7, 2023. Host venue was Village Presbyterian Church in Prairie Village, Kansas (Dr. Elisa Williams Bickers, FAGO, Principal Organist and Associate Music Director). Bachathon Organizer was Dan Madura. Bachathon 44 was made possible in part by grants from the Ellen French Memorial Fund and by the Martha Lee Cain Tranby Music Enrichment Fund.

Dan Madura was host announcer for Bachathon 44. Rick Deasley was designer of the printed program, Debbie Lynch coordinated advertising to the printed program, Mike Maiden, Tom Watgen and Debbie Winter coordinated publicity and social media. # FROM THE DIRECTORY CHAIR

## **New Question During Renewal**

There has been a change in ONCARD as you renew your membership. There is a required field that asks you if you want the traditional printed directory mailed to you or if you want to opt out and use the online directory that is available for your PC and phone.

Receive Yearly Printed Directory:

NO – I will use the digital phone/desktop directory

YES – I would like a printed directory

Why are we asking this question?

Over the past few years, printing and postage costs to the chapter have gone up substantially. The time commitment to producing the printed directory is substantial. This is costing the chapter valuable resources that can be used towards other things such as programming and administrative costs. A few years ago, we made a very modest investment in Instant Church Directory. It is very easy to maintain. We have received many positive reviews of this new digital format. Benefits of using this directory:

- It is at your fingertips when you are writing emails to friends on your desktop computer.
- It is on your phone when you are on the go.
- It is updated monthly, while the printed version is only updated yearly.
- There is no cost to you to use it.
- It has the following content:
  - o Members contact information with pictures (if submitted).
  - o Board members and contacts. o Teams (committees) contacts.
  - o Chapter sponsored concerts (updated as changes occur).
  - o Ability to submit changes to your contact information.
  - o Future enhancements:
    - Attachments for download (Operating Procedures, etc.)
    - § Downloading ability of a print ready version of the directory. You will be able to print what you need on your own printer.
    - ← Links to our website, the national website and ONCARD, and links to other pertinent organizations to our chapter.

At the bottom of this article are some screenshots of the personal computer and phone versions.

How do I get the digital directory?

To get started, go to GKCAGO Directory <a href="https://members.instantchurchdirectory.com/">https://members.instantchurchdirectory.com/</a>

You will be asked to enter your email address as it's listed in our directory. Once you enter your email address, follow the directions on-screen to complete the create log-in process. After you sign in, you'll see the most up-to -date directory for our chapter. Any time updates are made, they will show on the Online Members' Website, too. You can make these updates through the online directory, or through AGO's website through the ONCARD system. We also would like to see who you are! Please submit a photo either through the app or you can email it to me.

Our chapter directory is available to view on your mobile device also! Instant Church Directory - the program we use to build our chapter directory - has a free app for chapter members to download on their Apple and Android devices.


