GKCAGO: A NEW STRUCTURE!

At the October 23, 2021 Special Called Board Meeting, those GKCAGO Board members present, who constituted a quorum, unanimously approved the Board Restructuring Motions put forth by the Operating Procedures Board Restructuring Committee. Transitional implementation of this new GKCAGO Board structure will begin on January 1, 2022. Highlights of the new GKCAGO Board Structure moving forward are —

ELEVEN ELECTED GKCAGO Board members:

Five Officers: Dean, Sub-Dean, Treasurer, Secretary, Registrar; elected for TWO-YEAR terms in ODD NUMBERED YEARS (elected for transitional ONE-YEAR term in 2022)

Six Team Leaders: Education, Program, Membership, Administration, Finance, Information; elected for TWO-YEAR terms in EVEN NUMBERED YEARS

Bi-Monthly Board meetings in odd-numbered months

Bi-Monthly Team meetings in even-numbered months, as appropriate/necessary

Current Committee Chairs now referred to as "Team Members"

Team Leaders are liaisons between teams/ committees and the Board

"Strategic Planning" Committee with defined role description replaces "Long Range Planning" Committee

Finance Team replaces Finance and Investment Advisory Committees

Interim Team Leaders appointed (1/1/22 – 6/30/22), who may stand for election in April

At the November 13th Board meeting, revised DRAFT GKCAGO Operating Procedures will be discussed and voted upon by all current GKCAGO Board members in attendance. Following that meeting, ALL CHAPTER MEMBERS are asked to WATCH FOR additional Email blasts, kcago.com postings, and the December Edition of *Bombarde* for more restructuring details!!
